HIGH POINT CIRCUIT AWARDS AT FALL SHOW – CLASS CIRCUIT AWARDS AT WISCONSIN

High Point Awards: Open Stallion, Open Mare, Open Gelding, Open Color, Open Junior Horse, Open Senior Horse, Amateur, Novice Amateur, Amateur Select, Novice Youth, Youth 5 -9, Youth 13 and under, and Youth 14 - 18.

To be eligible for High Point Circuit Awards, exhibitor must show in halter or color class. Exhibitors must show each day of the circuit. For all award divisions except halter and color, exhibitors must show in at least two performance classes each day. Showmanship is considered a performance class for these awards.

HIGH POINT YEAR END AWARDS

PEAI year-end High Point Awards are open to both In-state and Out-of-state exhibitors. To be eligible, exhibitors must nominate their horse or horses prior to showing at the circuit. Out of state exhibitors must join PEA I and pay a \$5.00 membership fee. All exhibitors must show to a minimum of 6 out of the 15 total judges and **each exhibitor or an exhibitor's representative must work two work segments during the show season.** Nomination forms are available from Lynn Rohwedder or Deana Nell or at the shows.

The Stake classes (noted on show bill with an "S") will be run concurrently with corresponding PHBA class, with the exception of the rainbow halter classes and walk/trot. The entry fee for each stakes class is \$25.00 plus a \$5.00 office fee; 100% of all entry fees will be paid back. **Plus \$50.00 will be added to each Stakes class that has 5 or more entries.** Each Stakes class exhibitor must also enter corresponding PHBA class, with the exception of the open walk/trot and the rainbow yearlings and weanlings. The walk/trot horses can enter any PHBA class to be eligible. The rainbow horses are entered in the Stakes only. Stakes weanling and yearling classes are open to non-palomino, provided one parent is a palomino. Proof of parentage and registration must be provided. See Stakes entry form for other rules.
